The covered pavilion in **Kunkel Park** can be reserved by permit for use for special events. Use of the park by25 or more people also requires a permit.

The daily fee for Pennington Borough residents and for documented non-profit organizations is \$75. The fee for all others is \$200.

Application for a park permit must be submitted ten (10) days in advance of the event. Reservations are made on a first come, first served basis. No refunds or change of reservation date will be allowed once a permit is issued.

By reserving the Park, you are aware of and agree to comply with all regulations as specified in Borough Code \$143-3. A summary of regulations is provided on the reverse side of this application.

You are responsible for cleaning up after your event. Please bring extra plastic or paper trash bags to the gathering. Place bags of trash in the trash containers or beside the containers if the containers are full. Please recycle when possible.

Specialized recreation equipment, mechanical or carnival rides such as moon bounces, rides using livestock and petting zoos and/or displays using live animals are prohibited in Kunkel Park.

## § 143-3. Prohibited uses of park facilities.

• No animals shall be allowed to run at large within the parks of the Borough. Any animals being brought into the park facilities shall be restrained by appropriate leashes or otherwise under full control.

• No person shall cut, injure, deface, remove or disturb any tree, shrub, building, fence, bench, barbecue or any other structure owned or erected by others in the parks of the Borough; nor shall any person pick, cut or remove any shrub, brush or flower nor mark, write, paint or in any way deface any building fence, bench or other structure within the park area, it being the expressed intention of this chapter that those persons who use the Borough parks leave them in the same condition in which they found them.

• No person shall make or kindle an open fire in any area other than those set forth for barbecuing by the Borough or in containers or grills brought by the person to the park for the purpose of a barbecue.

• No person shall bring any intoxicating liquors or beverages into the parks.

• No organization (whether formal or informal) or group of people of 25 or more shall utilize the park facilities without first obtaining a permit as provided in § 143-4 hereof.

• No person shall remain in any park between the hours of dusk and sunrise, except by special permit.

• No person shall sell or offer for sale any object or merchandise or any other thing within the park, without first obtaining a permit as provided in § 143-4 hereof.

• No person shall operate any vehicle within the confines of any Borough park. Motor vehicles may be parked only in the designated motor vehicle parking area.

• No person shall smoke or be in possession of a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe or other matter or substance which contains tobacco or any other matter which is lighted or burning for the purpose of inhaling the smoke; consume smokeless tobacco; or use an electronic nicotine delivery system.
