

BULK TRASH ITEMS & STICKER PROGRAM GUIDELINES

Stickers may be purchased at the Pennington Borough Hall and placed on items - each sticker covers around 40 lbs. After stickers are affixed, items must be placed at the curb by **7am on the designated bulk collection day** stated on the calendar. See below for some examples.

BIODEGRADABLE LAWN BAGS, LEAF & BRUSH COLLECTION

All yard waste generated by a landscaper/contractor must be removed from the property by that party and may NOT be left at the curb. The only exception is leaves during vacuum leaf collection season.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

(BIODEGRADABLE BAGS, BUCKETS, OR CONTAINERS)

Throughout the year sticks, twigs, hedge trimmings, and leaves can be placed in biodegradable bags, buckets, or containers and will be collected every week. See below for details on vacuum curbside leaf collection information.

- The weight of bags/containers/buckets is **NOT** to exceed 40 lbs
- There will be **NO COLLECTION** of any yard waste in plastic bags
- Grass clippings are **NOT** permitted in the biodegradable lawn bags

LEAF COLLECTION

January 1st through September 30th leaves shall be placed in bags, buckets, or containers (see above). October 1st through December 31st leaves are collected via vacuum and shall be placed loosely along the curb.

- Do **NOT** place sticks, branches, stones, weeds, or mulched grass into the leaf pile
- Leaves shall be placed in a long, narrow pile
- Avoid blocking storm drains or flow of stormwater

!! For the month of March, bring leaves to curb for ADDITIONAL vacuum collection *LEAVES ONLY* !!

BRUSH COLLECTION (WOOD CHIPPER)

Brush collection is ongoing throughout the year (weather permitting).

- Stack brush on your side of the sidewalk with the butt end of the branch toward the road
- Keep branches long - 8' - 12' is good (the machine does not do well with short branches)
- Do **NOT** mix logs or vines with the brush

MONDAY COLLECTION

Pick up for: Abey Drive, Baldwin Court, Baldwin Street, Chadwell Court, East Curlis Avenue, East Delaware Avenue, East Franklin Avenue, East Welling Avenue, Eglantine Avenue, Fitz Charles Avenue, Kings Court, King George Road, Lewis Brook Road, Linden Lane, Mallard Drive, Maple Lane, North Main Street (Odd House #), North Riding Drive, Park Avenue, Queens Lane, Rockwell Green Drive, South Main Street (Odd House #), Scudder Court, Walking Purchase Avenue, and Weidel Drive

Collection begins at 7:00 am. Cart handles and wheels should be facing the house and the lid opening should be facing the street. All trash should be bagged before being placed in the cart and the lid should be fully closed.

Cancellation of trash collection may be necessary due to a declared State of Emergency or hazardous weather event. Notice of a cancellation will be posted on the Borough website. Cancelled collections will be scheduled for the next week day.

Accepted Materials:

- Mixed Paper, Office Paper, & Window Envelopes
- Corrugated Cardboard (placed in recycling bucket, tied, or at the curb)
- Cardboard Food Boxes & Powdered Detergent Boxes
- Telephone Books & Soft Cover (paperback) Books
- Hard Cover Books (hardcover must be removed)
- Glass Food & Beverage Jars/Bottles (all colors)
- Aluminum & Metal Beverage Containers
- Juice Boxes & Juice/Beverage Cartons
- Milk Jugs & Plastic Beverage Bottles
- Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs
- Detergent & Shampoo Containers
- Plastics with #1 or #2 Symbols

Materials NOT Accepted:

- Plastic Bags and Pizza Boxes
- Light Bulbs & Styrofoam
- Aluminum Foil/Baking Pans
- Drinking Glasses, Dishes, & Broken Window Glass
- Wax Paper, Tissue Paper, Napkins, Paper Plates & Paper Towels
- Ceramics & Pottery
- Clothes Hangers & Aerosol Cans
- Motor Oils & Anti-Freeze Containers
- Plastics with #3 - #7 Symbols
